### Hack Classes

Pony hack under 14hh, Light Hack 14hh U 15hh, Hack over 15hh, Associate hack, Led Hack, Beginner Hack

Champion and Reserve Hack (pony, light hack, Hack & Associate)

### Rider Classes

Led, Beginners, U7, U9, U11, U13, U15, U17, Associates

Boys and girls are combined for rider classes

Champion and Reserve Sub-Junior (U7, U9), Junior (U9, U13), Senior (U15, U17) & Associate Rider

### Pairs

Led, Beginner, Sub-Junior (U7, U9), Junior (U9, U13), Senior (U15, U17) & Associate Rider

### Sporting

Bends, Barrels, Key hole, Washington bends

Led, Beginners, U7, U9, U11, U13, U15, U17, Associates Boys and girls are combined for rider classes

### Show jumping

F grade will be open to all riders that do not hold a club grading from beginners to under 17 years.

Rider may enter on a CLUB grading for E and D grades. All other heights must be Zone graded.

AM3- F grade Beginner, U 17

AM7- U17 years E D C B A (with height rise)

AM7- Associate E D C B A (with height rise)

### Rules & Requirements

- Competitors & persons entering grounds do so at their own risk.
- All competitors must be a financial member of a Pony Club affiliated with the PCA of NSW.
- No overall point score will be run at this event.
- Gear Check is compulsory for all competitors
- One horse, one rider applies to all competitors
- Age of rider is their age on day of competition
- Full Pony Club uniform must be worn for Hack classes. Club t- shirts are permitted for jumping and sporting.
- Led & Beginner riders not eligible for champion rider.
- Led riders are excluded from Show jumping
- Led riders must be led from the shoulder by a PC member over 17 years and must stay on the lead all competition.
- Led riders will be placed in hack, rider and pairs on their ability, same colour ribbons will be awarded to each rider for the sporting events and will not be timed
- Beginner riders must only walk and trot, no cantering.
- Beginner riders may enter F grade show jumping
- Ribbons to sixth place.
- Judges decision is final.
- The committee reserves the right to alter the program at any time.
- Pony Club, nor its office holders will be held responsible for any loss or injury to spectators, riders, animals or property.
